April 20 & 21

Setting up for one of our rummage sales takes a small army of volunteers, working for at least three hours on Friday morning, to move boxes out of storage, unpack and display the items for sale. Then there are a goodly number of people who come in to do the selling on Saturday, and following the sale whatever is unsold must either be packed and stored for the next sale or packed for pick-up by a local charity.

It is no wonder then, with all the work involved in setting up for the Rummage Sale, that we have often been questioned about the short 'selling' time (9:30 to 1:00 on Saturday). This year we have decided to take a risk and try something new, and that is to open our doors to the public on Friday from 4:00 to 8:00 as well as the usual hours on Saturday.
