These Design Labs will focus on a number of priority issues identified at the Community Summit for Regina's Plan to End Homelessness we hosted in March of this year. Community participants were very eager to tackle

several issues at the Summit in an inclusive and respectful manner. It is imperative to have key stakeholders join the discussion and to be active participants in this Design Lab process. This is a process of empowerment, education, relationship building and reconciliation that is essential to address the needs of the City of Regina. Each Design Lab is scheduled for two hours and will include introductions, objective setting, issue overview, clarifying deliverables, setting boundaries, breakout sessions, discussion and action planning.
