**Fundscrip** is a way to *order gift cards* to a variety of places (see attached list) and a percentage of the dollar value of the card goes back to the church. For example, if you were to order a \$100 gift card from Safeway, the church would receive 3% or \$3.

There are grocery stores, gas stations, restaurants, clothing stores, toy stores, entertainment, hotels and the list goes on.

If you were thinking of spending \$300 on groceries on your Christmas grocery shopping list, you could purchase \$300 worth of gift cards and a percentage goes to the church. Doing renos, get some cards from Home Depot! Need gas for yourself, get some gift cards!

It is the perfect time of year to buy cards and at the same time, support the church.

Fill out the form, bring it back to the church or call Lois at 306-543-4850 or Kay at 306-543-6129 to give your order over the phone. You will need to pay for the cards before receiving them. The church will accept cheques, cash or e-transfer. It will take 3-5 business days for the cards to arrive at the church after ordering. Our **first** order date is **November 27**. The larger the order, the less shipping cost.

Pick up will be Sunday mornings or at the office unless Covid changes things, pick up will be at the office only. For special circumstances, we will arrange to have cards delivered by volunteers.
