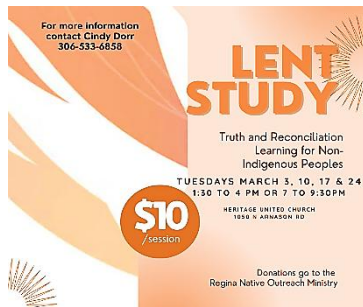
### Ash Wednesday
