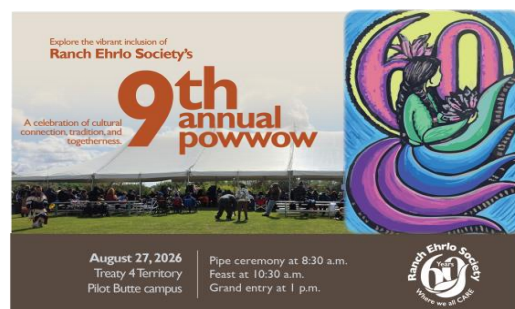


WUC Justice & Reconciliation News
