9th Annual powwow at Ranch Ehrlo - Pilot Butte campus

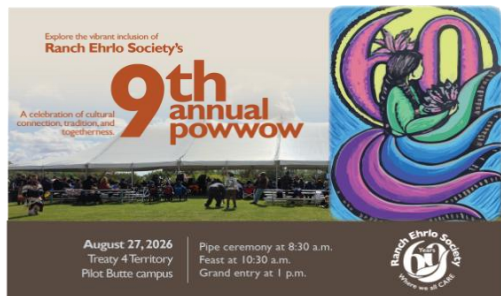
A group from our church will be attending, and we would love you to join us for an afternoon of culture, learning, and community. The Grand Entry begins at 1:00 p.m.
